## **ATHENS\_DELPHI**

The aim of the educational journey is to promote, through the teacher's experience, the project/event "**Agòn**" towards all European students, especially, the theoretical and practical aspect of disciplines linked to ancient greek culture, as well as to share goals, vision and learning methods, in an international perspective, during this short but intense experiential historical journey.

### **Event short program:**

#### **Day 1 - Arrival in Athens**

**Night walking visit** of Athens historical center and dinner **symposium** style (Plato, Aristotle and the Olympics)

#### **Day 2 - Along the path of Apollo**

**Visit** of Delphi archeological area, **guided tour** and **poetical musical representation** (Pindar, Homeric Hymn and muses). **Lunch** in Delphi, **Practical workshop** experience of Artifact and Sculpture. Evening: **debate**

#### **Day 3 - Along the path of Athena**

**Visit** of the archeological area of Athens, **guided tour**, **theatrical tragedy and comedy representation** (Aeschylus, Sophocles, Aristophanes).

Afternoon: Departure

### **Participation info:**

- The cost of the participation to the program/event is taken in charge by our organization, as incentive to promote the project.
- Hotel accommodation 3\*/4\* with breakfast, excursion transfers, guided tours, artistic representations and workshops are at the charges of our organization.
- Flights round trip to and from Athens are not included and are at the charges of the participant.

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## **Requirements:**

- Participants must currently teach one of the following disciplines: History, Literature, philosophy, foreign languages, human sciences, arts, sports, design, to high school students aged between 14 and 19 years old who are oriented in classical, scientific, humanistic, artistic, musical, dancing, sporting, touristic and foreign languages studies.
- An online project presentation to the students of each participating teacher has to be organized before the event. Presentation duration 1h.

## **Good to Know:**

- The international project is organized by the non profit Italian-Greek association “**EUROPEAN FESTIVAL OF ANCIENT GREECE**”.
- To create a European high school network, the availability is limited to cover specific academic institution from different countries.
- The journey is going to be organized with minimum 15 participants.
- The invitation is extended to minimum 5 EU countries.
- The teacher’s educational path will be held in English Language.
