

## Short presentation:

Through initiatives that foster relationship and comparison in a European perspective, students and individuals participate in training activities with a free methodology (inductive method, cooperative

The event is an opportunity to meet and confront with participants from different countries, different schools and cultures, to strengthen the identity of the European Community.
